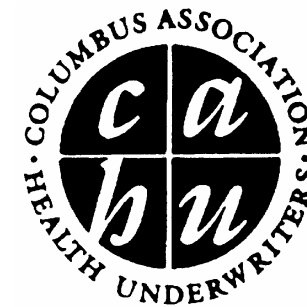

NAHU is your voice in Washington! Each year NAHU spends over \$1,000,000 to present your interests before Congress and regulatory agencies. NAHU holds leadership positions in over a dozen DC based health-care coalitions lobbying congress on pertinent issues. NAHU's Grassroots Network targets federal and state legislators with information and lobbying materials in advance of significant legislative votes.

Legislation

At both the state and federal levels, your Health Underwriters Association advocate for your interests, actively representing your needs and concerns to government officials. NAHU's work on Capitol Hill was instrumental in the defeat of nationalized healthcare in 1994. OAHU's involvement at the state level helped to craft small group reform and agent licensing legislation. OAHU introduced Senate Bill 123 which will create the Ohio Health Insurance Risk Pool. The Ohio Health Insurance Risk Pool will provide coverage for approximately 10,000 Ohioans who cannot get insurance because of medical history or who are faced with premiums so high they can't afford them! No one program can solve all of the problems facing Ohio. But, the Ohio Health Insurance Risk Pool is a great start!
